



## **Y Outdoor Activities COVID 19 Protocols**

- Parents are to park and come directly to the field. Do not enter the building.
- Masks are required for both participants and their parent when they are traveling from their vehicle to the fields and back. Children will remove masks when play begins, but are welcome to keep them on during this time if the parent requests they do. Parents need to remain masked if they are unable to social distance while spectating. If you are able to social distance from others not in your household masks may be removed.
- Participants shall not show up more than 10 minutes before the start of their game. If the game before yours is running overtime, please do not enter the playing area until that game is complete and players and spectators have departed.
- Children will be grouped with a coach and will remain with that same group of children and coach throughout the entire program.
- Please bring a small plastic bag with your child's name on it so they can place their mask in it during play.
- Please have your child bring a spill proof water bottle with their name clearly marked on it.
- Children will be allowed to have 4 spectators at their game. Siblings that play soccer will not count as a spectator but must remain with their parents during their siblings game. They will not be allowed to run around the fields. Siblings that do not play soccer will be counted as a spectator.
- Please depart immediately following your game so other participants may get on the field. If you have another game that is not immediately following the one you just completed, you must leave the fields and come back at your scheduled time.
- All program participants are asked to stay home if sick and will be required to adhere to health screening protocols upon arrival at the Y.
- Participants that have been identified as a close contact with anyone known to have a lab-confirmed case of COVID-19 within the past 14 days will not be allowed to attend the program until they are cleared by a health professional or public health to return.
- If a participant exhibits symptoms while participating they will be sent home immediately.
- If anyone involved in the program, child or staff, is diagnosed with COVID-19 all players/parents considered a close contact will be notified promptly. We will work with the health department to ensure all close contacts are identified and contacted and will follow Public Health's recommendations to determine the continuation of the program.
